### **Librarian Makes House Calls**

If you are having difficulty finding articles online, want to learn a better way to search CINAHL, or are unsure what CINAL is, I can help, and you don't have to come to the Library! Make an appointment with me to come to your work location at time that works with your schedule.

For example, I can:

- (1) train you to search CINAHL or PubMed to find articles;
- (2) show you how to find the most current books in your specialty;
- (3) help you find online books such as dictionaries and handbooks;
- (4) demonstrate how to use RefWorks to organize research and create bibliographies.

## Featured Resources

### Find information on your research topic with CINAHL

CINAHL is the premier nursing database covering almost 3,000 journals from the fields of nursing and allied health. It contains more than 1 million citations to journal articles dating back to 1981.

Search limiters such as Peer-Reviewed, Research Article, and Evidence-Based Practice help you retrieve high quality articles.

### [Lens](#) Offers New, Interactive Features and More Digital Photographs

New interactive features in Lens, the Library's search engine, allow you to make lists and to tag, rate, and review books, DVDs, journals, and more for future reference. To get started, click the "My Discoveries" box found on the right side of the maroon-colored banner at the top of any Lens page. Register to create an account; click "Help" for directions, if needed. Send your comments about these new features by clicking "Feedback" at the bottom of any Lens page.

In addition, thousands of images from the University's [Archival Photographic Files](#) can now be discovered via Lens. Try sample searches in Lens such as "nurse" or "Chicago Lying-In Hospital" to view such results. Currently, photographs cannot be tagged, but we plan to add this functionality in the future.
