Tom de Burg grants and confirms the donation of Adam de Cokefeld to Gilibert his son and Nicholas the priest of Foxherd the messuage of Galter Widecote of Foxherd and of all land named in the charter of the said Adam de Cokefeld, with issues of said land and of all the meadow which Turgarius the miller held between the house of Tom and the meadow of Robert de Bellod Campo with its pits. Witnesses: Sir Geoffrey de Burgate, Archdeacon of Norwich, Master Nicholas and Alexander, chaplains, Herueus and Robert, the chaplains "le les", Hugo de Costune, Robert haldone, Gillo (Wm.) de Aleto, "Amiano" de Mora, Robert de Hibernis, Hugo Walensis, Hugo de Helissani, et al.

No date. Geoffrey, Archdeacon of Norwich, lived in the time of King John.
