A deed in which Adam de Chefrevill grants to Peter de Reydon a piece of land in Reydon called "Hogheslond" in return for twelve shillings sterling. Dated at Reydon, April 4, thirty-third year of King Edward (Edward I, 1305).

Note the pun on the name Chefrevill (Latin capravilla) in the use of the goat () on the ^{Triangular} seal.

Attached to the deed by a handmade pin is an index in a fourteenth century hand, listing various other deeds by Chefrevill and other ~~expresses of~~ ^{and} including the one to which it is attached. The others have become separated from the index slip but may perhaps exist in the collection.

The second deed, by the same man, who this time spells his name Chenuill, shows a clearer impression of the seal on green wax.
