John de Swyneford, referring to fine at Westminster before the King's Bench "in the month of Easter"(sic) 8th Edward II, by which Oliver de Wachesham, parson of the church of Bourgate & Robert le Carter, chaplain, rendered the manor of Bourgate to Sir Peter Bourgate, agrees on behalf of himself, his wife Agnes, & their heirs to hold Sir Peter clear of any "waste, destruction, or exile" in the manor under penalty of 200l.

Witnesses: John de Thelnetham, William de Ipswich, Thomas de Kyppeham, Adam de Brown^m, John le May, Peter Unwyne, Robert de Hoppeton, clerk, & others. At Bourgate, July 4, 8th year of Edward son of Edward.
