Charter by Edmond de Playford, vicar of church of Kenton to Margaret who was wife of D. Robt. de Swyneford, kt., and Peter, son of Robt. of all his lands in Suff., in villages of Burgate, Melles, Trandiston, Wortham, Palegrave, Redegrave, Gisltingham and Westthorp which lands Robt. de Kenton, Richard Stanground, chaplain, and Edmond de Playford had by grant of D. Robt. de Swynneford (except the manor of Burgate and the advowson of church of Burgate in which manor and advowson the said Margaret is enfeoffed by fine in the King's curia.
