 reign of our said lord King Henry the eight, witnesseth that  
 Thomas Worsley of London gent. James baron of Worsley Baron of London etc.  
 all his tenement house and garden in the parishes of Saynt Botolph  
 without the Bishoppe gate of London late part of the possession and reversion  
 of the late hospital of Saynt Maries Spittle and now or late in the  
 hands of messrs or carpenters of Wyddon and ley willm Bentill  
 George hollow willm Galanos Richard garnett willm  
 Gurley & Richard prest, John mit brown, Benjamin  
 Dymme, John Waller, James Reynolds, John Goffe, John Kelley  
 John Gault offe wyse, all the said Edward, all witnesses the said  
 Thomas baron hath sold to me the said John Worsley for the sum  
 of two hundred and fifty pounds and eight pence six farthings  
 sterling & for the value of the said premises shall be due at the feast  
 of Saynt Michael next after the date hereof whiche said sum  
 of two hundred and fifty pounds and eight pence six farthings  
 sterling together with the said value of the said premises shall be  
 at my said baron's charge & the said John Worsley do bynde me  
 my heirs executors and assigns by the said statute well & law  
 content and paye or cause to be contented & payed to the said Thomas  
 his executors or assigns immediately upon the assurance of the said  
 to be made to me the said John Worsley & to my heirs executors for witness  
 whereof I the said John Worsley have subscribed this bill at  
 my hand and seal the day and year first above written  
 And it is agreed between the said Thomas baron & the said John Worsley  
 that the said John shall paye of the said sum above written in hand  
 down of one hundred and fifty pounds the rest in the rate at my said  
 baron's
