KNOW YE, That pursuant to the Constitution and Laws of our said State, WE have appointed and constituted, and by these Presents, DO appoint and constitute *Job Fish, Lieutenant in a a a a* the *39th* Regiment of *Infantry* of our said State, (with rank from *May 26th 1825 a a*) To hold the said Office in the manner specified in and by our said Constitution and Laws.

In Testimony whereof, We have caused our Seal for Military Commissions to be hereunto affixed: Witness **DE WITT CLINTON**, Esquire, Governor of our said State, General and Commander in Chief of all the Militia, and Admiral of the Navy of the same, at our City of Albany, the *18th* day of *June* in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty-five *De Witt Clinton*
