Sir

On examining the files in this Office I find that only five States namely New Hampshire, Massachusetts, New York, Maryland, and Virginia have transmitted their Laws passed in pursuance of the Recommendation of Congress of the 30th April 1784. It is suggested that other States have complied with the Recommendation, though their Laws have not been forwarded. I therefore take the Liberty of enclosing the Act, and request the favour of your Excellency to inform me what your Legislature have done, and if they have complied that you would be pleased to transmit me a Copy of their Act that I may report the same to Congress. —
