GREETINGS FROM GARRY-NEE-DULE

We hope that, as a flower lover, you are interested in all the lovely gardens in this combined exhibit.

You will find many types of gardens represented here, all of them worthy of careful study and observation for ideas adaptable to your own garden.

The offering of W. A. Toole of Garry-nee-Dule, from Baraboo, Wis., is an informal arrangement with a tea house overlooking a lily pool. A low terrace with rocks and rock garden plants at the back of the garden merges into the perennial border surrounding the lawn.

A special bit of interest is the arrangement of Herbs at the stepping stone entrance to the garden.

This garden might be readily adapted to almost any small or medium back yard.

The aim has been to produce a peaceful, quiet spot where tired nerves and bodies may rest. The materials used may be varied to suit different conditions and various tastes.

Inside the Exhibition Hall, you will find a dozen lovely dioramas, each a picture in itself. Included among these are two prepared by Mr. W. A. Toole of Garry-nee-Dule. One scene is of a Swiss Mountain Valley, with alpine grasses and flowers in the foreground, leading into the background of high alpine peaks.

Nearly opposite is a dripping cliff, and a corner of a tamarack swamp, with higher ground at one side. This scene, with its ferns and wild flowers is typical of some of the natural scenery around our little city of Baraboo. If you are hunting for a restful place to spend a vacation, why not try Baraboo, which is close to beautiful Devil's Lake State Park and the famous Dells of the Wisconsin River.
