Date: 12 cent. at the end, France

Script: French Gothic characters of the end of the 12. century

ii as ij, but with ~~xx~~ dashes

some minuscule d, but mostly uncial form

~~sometimes~~ old-fashioned long f at the end of words *is regular*

Text: Biblical quotations are not normalized as in the edition of Migne.

The text is according to the manuscript from (or in) Toulouse

(as you may see from a footnote for page 1 col. b line 3 f.)

also for page 2 col. b line 3 from *the bottom*

So this version can be combined with the French family of the tradition of Saint Jerome's book.

History of the fragment:

The two long pages were used as an envelop.

At the left margin of the first page is the title:

P A L L A D I U S  
*περι Βραχυμᾶνων*

The letters are written in the capitalis of the XVI./XVII cent.

So the fragment may be used for a copy of the editio princeps of this 4th century author's book Lipsiae 1571.
