Text:

Script: Carolingian letters, still of low character  
a with an oblique stroke  
r has a long stroke exceding the line  
always long  $\int$   
g closed  
ae always as  $\text{e}$   
very characteristic is the  $\chi$  where the second stroke is looking down  
(The same in the glosses between the lines)
