

Dear Sir,

I am sorry to say I have failed entirely in all my efforts to secure you a publisher for the Lincoln Biography, as well as to dispose of the plates of the old work.

Until this week I have rather expected a favorable reply from one party, and for that reason have delayed writing to you. Publishers are indisposed to consider anything connected with the rebellion, and appear to think the magazine publishers must monopolize everything of that sort.
