

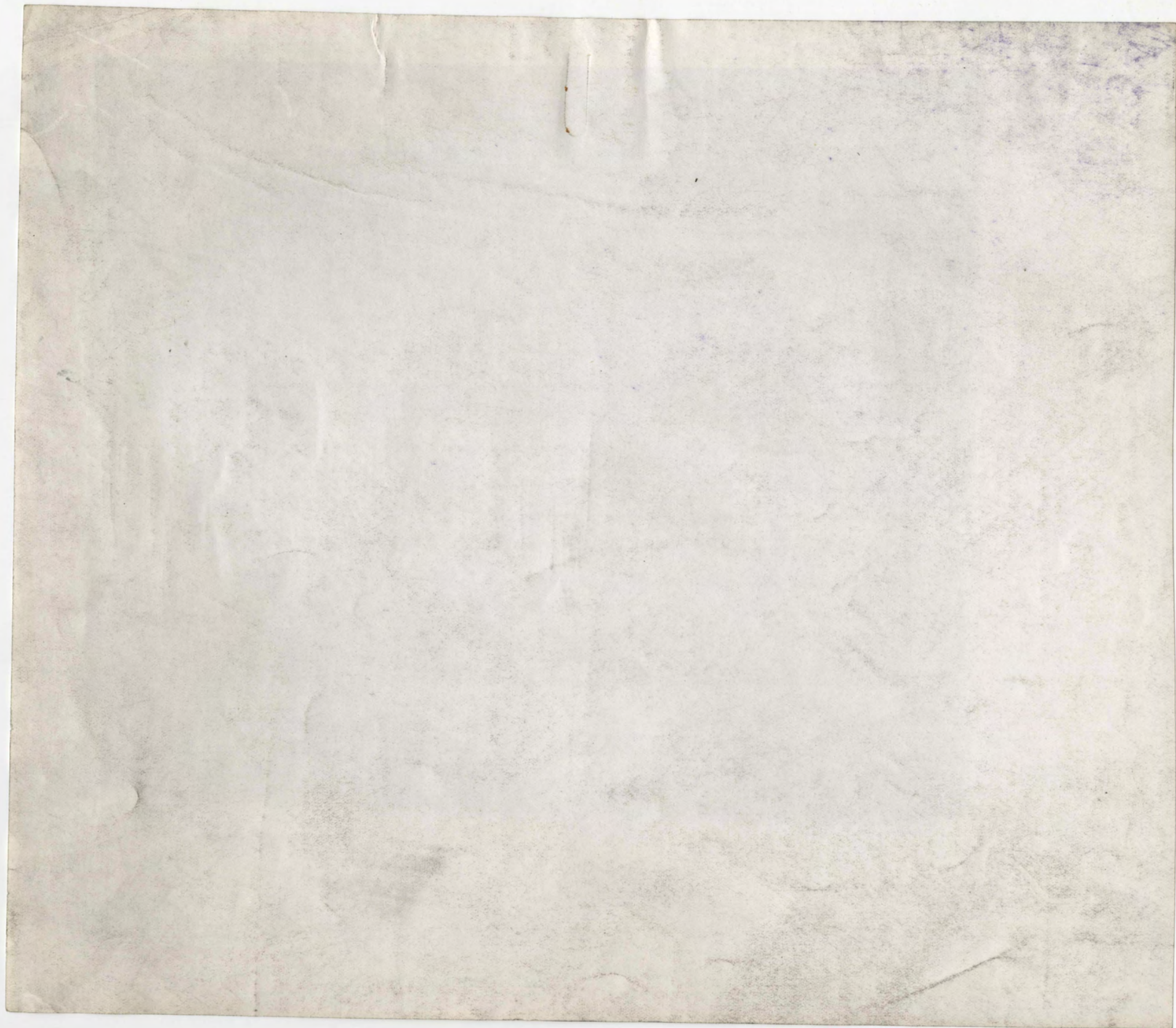
Springfield, April 19th 1837
