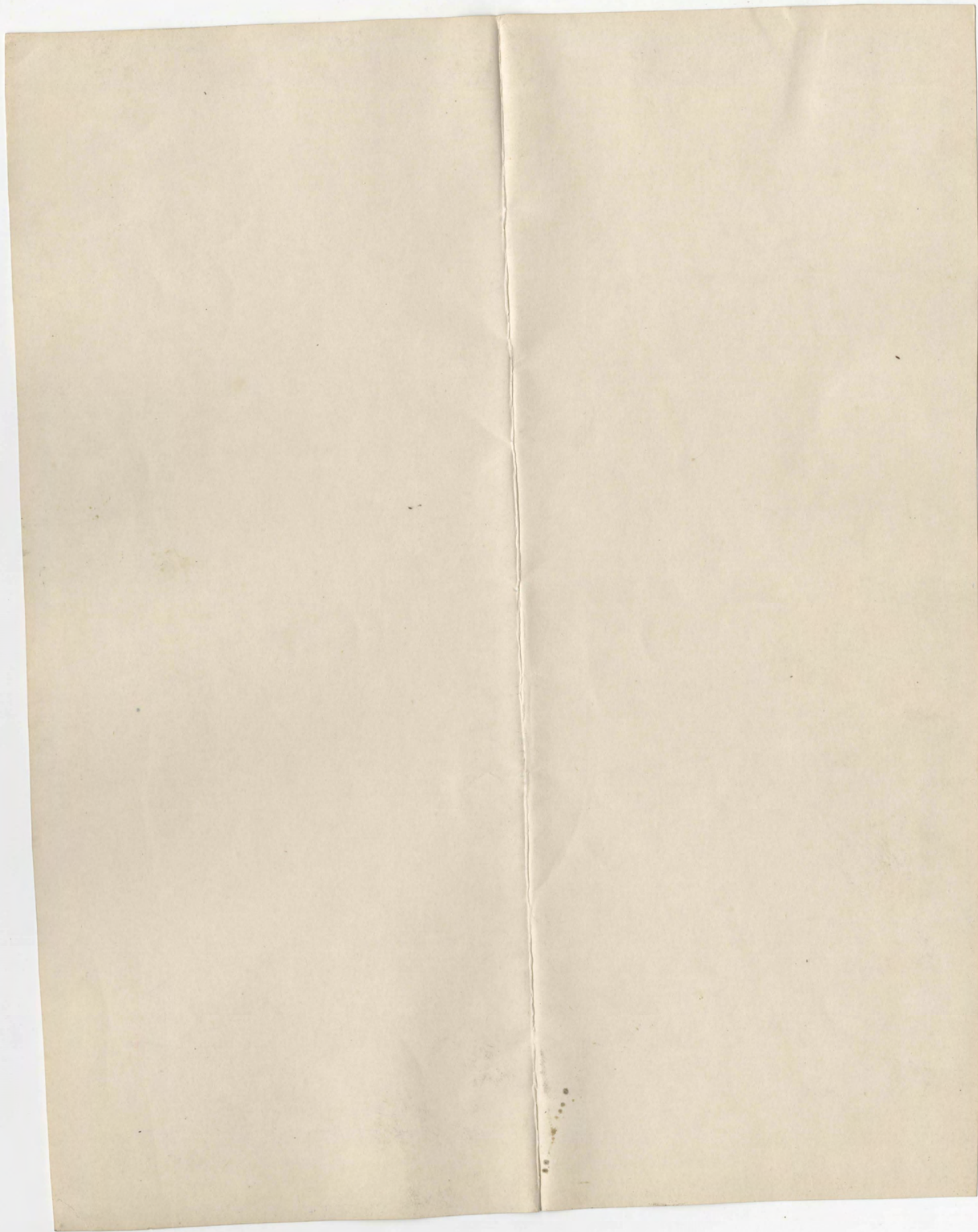


Springfield, April 24th 1846
