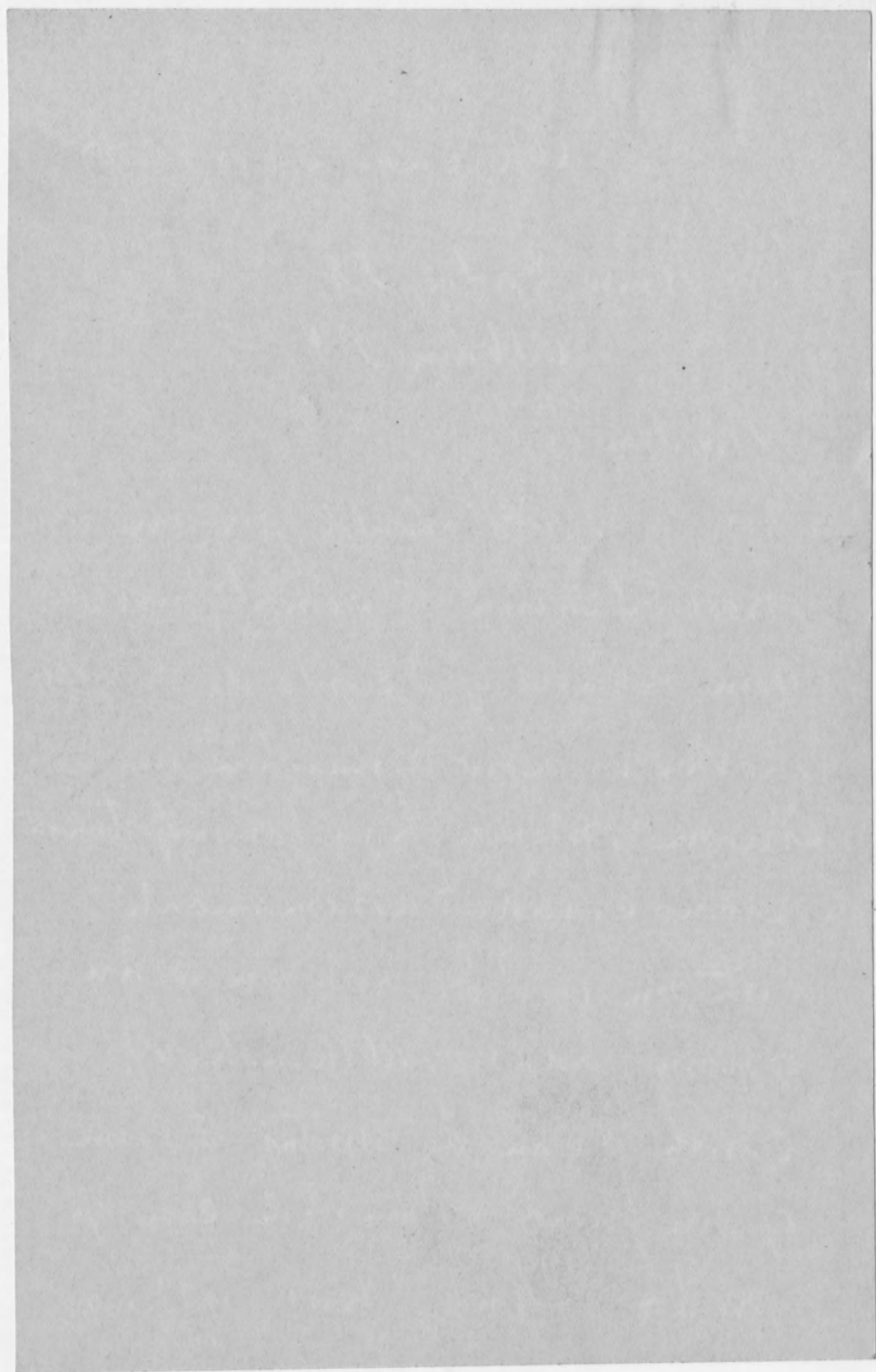

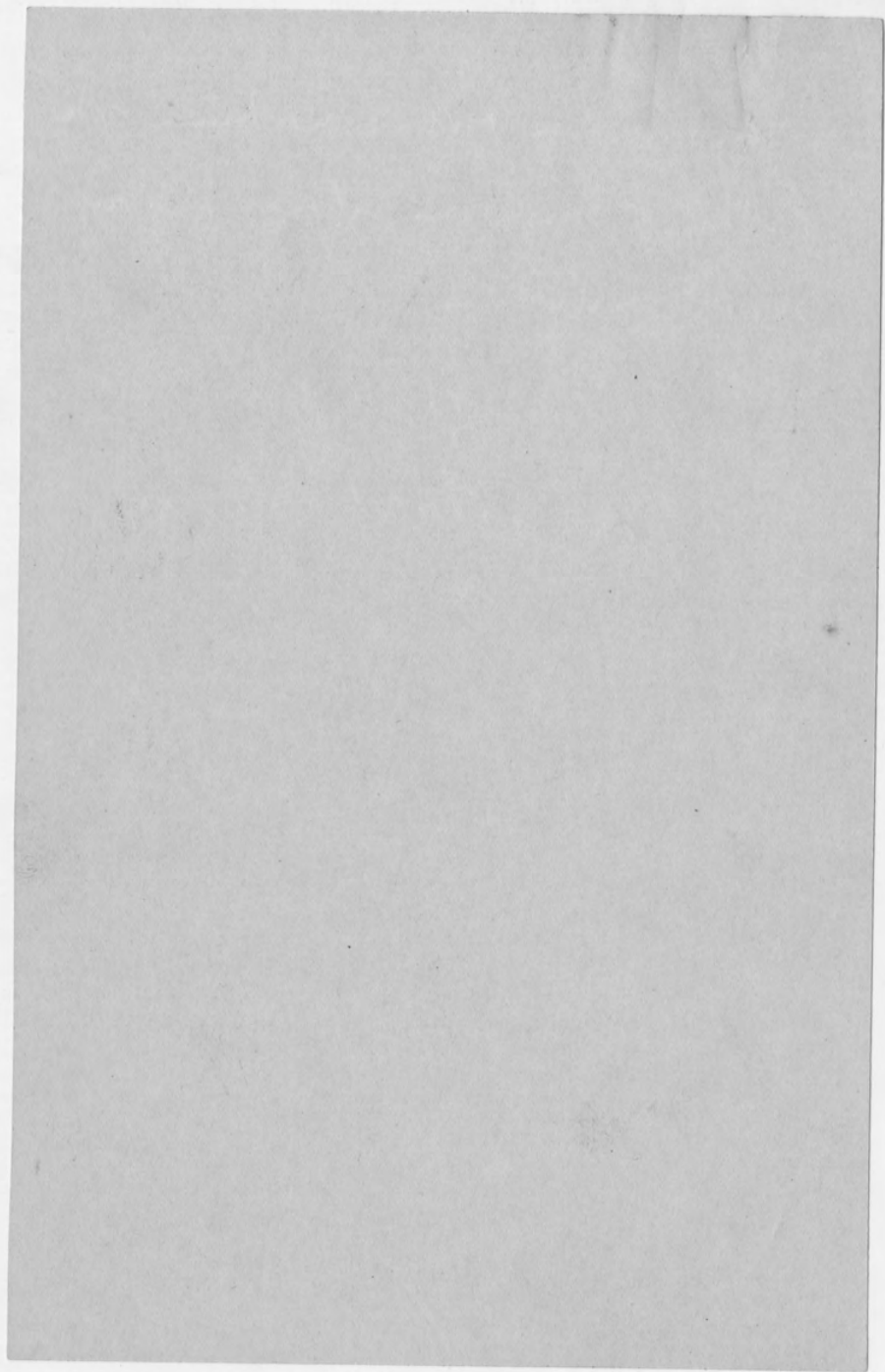
My dear Sir:

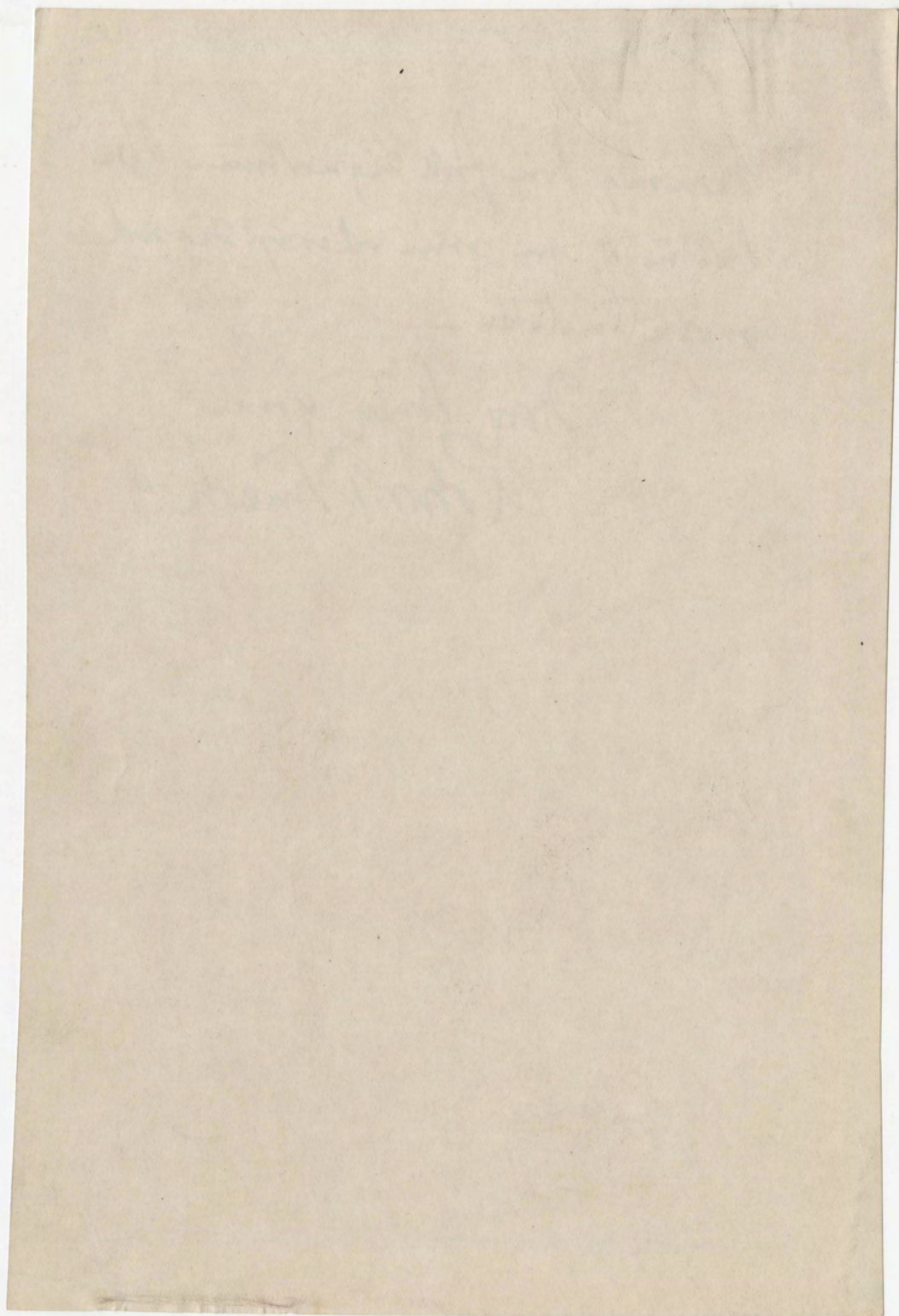
