




Know all men by these presents, that we Thomas Lincoln
N. Moser Kirkpatrick Jesse Geare held us firmly bound unto his
Excellency James Garrard Esquire Governor of Kentucky in the
penal sum of five hundred dollars current money the payment
of which well be truly to be made to the said Governor and his
Successors we hereby bind ourselves our Heirs &c. Jointly and severally
firmly by these presents sealed with our seals and dated this 19th day
of January 1802

The Condition of the above Obligation is such that if the above
bound Thomas Lincoln — a Constable of the County of
Cumberland shall by himself well be truly collect all Officers fees
put into his hands to collect & account for & pay the same
at such time & in such manner as is directed by Law shall
well be truly execute and due returns make of all process and
precepts to him directed or to him delivered and pay and satisfy
all sums of money & Fees by him received upon any such pro-
cess or precepts to the person or persons entitled thereto and in all
other things shall truly and faithfully execute & perform the said
Office of Constable according to law during the term of his
continuance therein, then the above Obligation to be void
else to remain in full force
