myself.

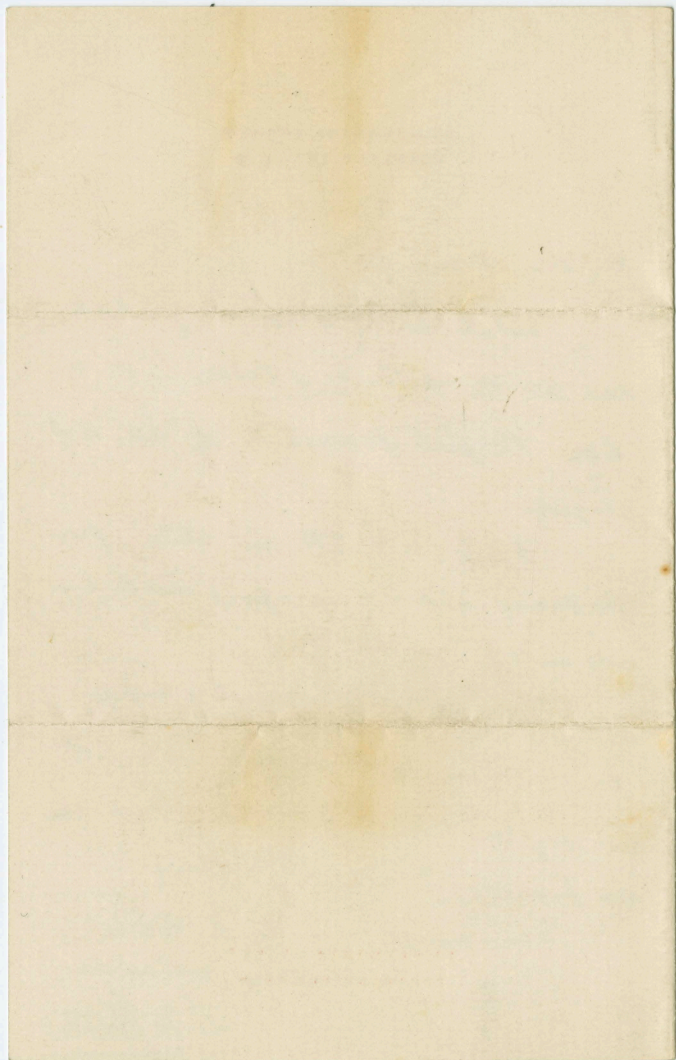
I will wait till you return from
