Dear Sir: I feel a deep interest
in the success of the new Chicago
University, and in the efforts which

I will give the sum of fifty
thousand dollars (50,000) to build
a woman's hall in the Chicago
University to be called the
"Foster Hall" and to be located
at the South East corner of the
University grounds.
