 Date here of untill he shall arrive to the age of twenty one
 years & yet P^r James Sverill Doth on his Part Promise that
 He will Provide Sutable vacate Drink Clothing washing
 Lodging for y^e P^r Apprentice & also to instruct P^r Apprentice
 to Read Moright & Sypher so far as to ~~the~~ ^{the} Key a book & also when
 The P^r Apprentice shall arrive to the age of twenty one
 years the P^r master is to Give to P^r Apprentice the sum of
 Twelve Pounds to be paid in Good or ~~the~~ ^{the} Chittels
 & to Give to P^r Apprentice a bible and two Good Suits
 of Sapprell one Sutable to ware at Common Labor
 & y^e other Decent to ware on Sunday
