

Know all Men by these presents that we John Fitzjarrald & John Robison of Lincoln County & State of Kentucky for & in consideration of the sum of one hundred & fifteen pounds current Money of the state aforesaid to us in hand paid by Jonathan Fortis of county & State aforesaid we have bargained & sold and by these presents do bargain and sell unto the aforesaid Jonathan Fortis one Negro man Slave named Peter aged thirty one years; being a Negro man that formerly belonged to Nathan Fortis deceased; which Negro man Peter we will warrant to be healthy sound & sensible clear of any impediments or disorders whatsoever, & will also warrant & forever defend the Right & title of S^r Negro from us our heirs Executors & Administrators and from all Manner of Person or persons whatsoever unto the aforesaid Jonathan Fortis his heirs Exors. admors. and assigns forever to him or there only proper Use & behoof in witness whereof we have hereunto put our hands & Seals this twenty Second day

June 1797
