Know all men by these presents, That I Gideon Evans of Barnwell District, for and in consideration of the love and affection which I have for my Daughter Lucretia the wife of Isaac C Johnson and in further consideration of the sum of five Dollars to me in hand paid by Sovereign S Evans the Receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge and for other good and valuable considerations me therunto moving, have granted, bargained, sold, and confirmed, and by these presents do, Grant, bargain sell and confirm, and deliver unto the said S. S. Evans his heirs and assigns, a Negro slave named Rose To Have and To Hold, the said Negro slave Rose together with her future increase unto the said S. S. Evans his heirs Executors administrators and assigns forever, In Trust nevertheless, and to and for and upon the uses and trusts Limitations and appointments hereinafter limited mentioned and declared of and concerning the same, That is to say In trust for the sole and separate use of my said Daughter Lucretia for and during her life, but not to be in any way subject to the business or future debts contracts or engagements of her present or future

Husband, And should the said Lucretia
die leaving issue alive at the time
of her death then and in that case
in Trust to convey and deliver the
said Slave Rose and her increase to
the said issue of the said Lucretia
to be equally divided and held by
them in Severalty, to themselves their
heirs and assigns forever, freed and
discharged of and from all further
and other Trusts and in case the
said Lucretia should die without
leaving issue alive at the time of
her death then in Trust to convey
and deliver the said Slave Rose
and her increase freed and dischar-
-ged from all trusts to the Brothers
and Sisters of the said Lucretia
the child or children of a deceased
Brother or Sister take in the Share of
his her or their Parents.
