## **Biographical Note**

Charlotte Comstock Gray was born in July 1842 in Albany, New York. She attended the College of Liberal Arts in Chautauqua, New York. In 1894 Gray entered the University of Chicago. She received an A.B. on July 1, 1897 and a D.B. on July 1, 1898 with a thesis titled "Michaelangelo and his Place in the Reformatory Movement." Gray entered the University of Chicago's Graduate School of Divinity, receiving a M.A. from the Department of Church History with a thesis titled "Visions of Saint Theresa" on January 21, 1900.
